SPECIAL COVID-19 UPDATE

05-28-2021.

Following the Ohio Department of Health's announcement <u>rescinding</u> COVID-19 mitigation measures on **6**-

2-2021, Ohio Conference Executive Administration have decided to lift the Ohio Conference COVID-19 guidelines for churches and entities across the Ohio Conference territory - beginning immediately. Unless otherwise advised by the Ohio Department of Health - local church boards and other Ohio Conference entities may end at their discretion implementation of mitigation measures including mask-wearing, social distancing, or other restrictions. Unvaccinated individuals may choose to continue practicing mitigation measures for themselves. As well, the Ohio Conference is pleased to officially re-open our Dayton office to the public beginning Tuesday, June 1st.



Memorial Day Memory
Desmond Doss would not
have stood out in a crowd as a
brave hero. But sometimes
looks can be deceiving. Doss

was a quiet, unassuming conscientious objector who served as a combat medic in World War II. He was twice awarded the Bronze Star for valor for risking his life in Guam & the Philippines. Also, awarded the Medal of Honor by President Truman in 1945 for single handily saving 75 wounded soldiers during fighting in Okinawa. All because he stuck to his Adventist beliefs and prayed for divine strength. Nothing is impossible with deep faith and trust in the Lord. Doss, a Lynchburg, VA naïve passed in 2006. The true movie *Hacksaw Ridge* was his story and was made to honor his heroics, but most importantly God's mighty power. We remember.
